### STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors.

<b>ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)</b>	
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for their loved one At the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	£2050.00
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£1200.00
Collecting and transporting of a loved one from the place of death into the funeral director's care.	£75.00
Care of a loved one before the funeral in appropriate facilities. They will reside at the Funeral Director's premises where a Chapel of Rest is available for viewings, upon request.	£150.00
Providing a suitable coffin - Brochures available on request.	From £350.00
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking a loved one direct to the agreed Cemetery or crematorium in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.	£275.00
<b>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</b>	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for their Loved one, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee) <sup>1</sup>	£1550.00
<b>FEES YOU MUST PAY</b>	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee varies. In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fees is:	
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot, for an existing grave with a memorial in place, You may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees. (This applies to an Interment of Ashes also.)	£900.00 - £1930.00
For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee varies. In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation is: (including Doctor's fees)	£1082.00

<b>ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES</b>	
This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, Or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:	
Flowers & Floral Tributes	From £50.00
Transport for Family/Mourners to and from the Funeral service (Limousines etc.)	£275.00
Embalming	£150.00
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc.)	From £200.00
Interment of Ashes (Administrative costs & Service)	£150.00

J Weekes Funeral Directors can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, So you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement or you can use a different supplier.

1. In England, Wales and Northern Ireland. You will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for a doctor to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
